

## **Report – Orientation Program for Fresher’s at Maliba Pharmacy College – 11-14 Sept 2017**

Maliba Pharmacy College, Bardoli organized an orientation programme for the newly admitted M.Pharm./B.Pharm./Pharm.D. students at the institute premises from 11<sup>th</sup> September to 14<sup>th</sup> September 2017.
