International Women's Day is a global day for celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. The day also marks a call to action for accelerating gender parity.

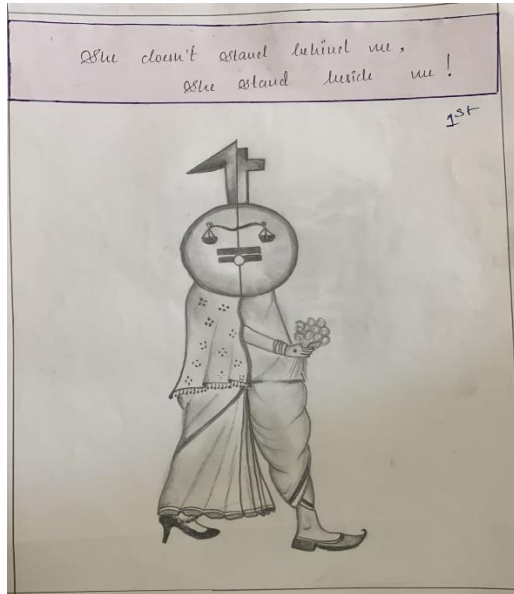

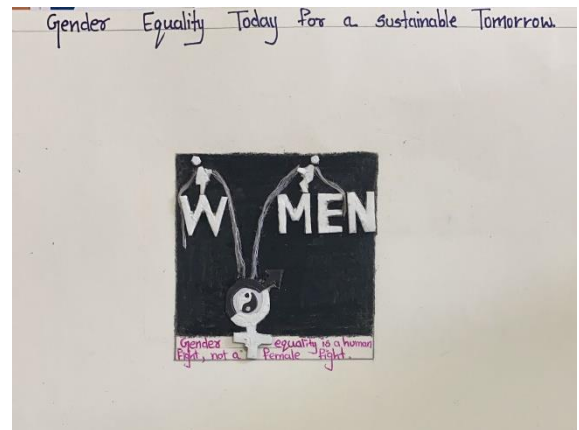

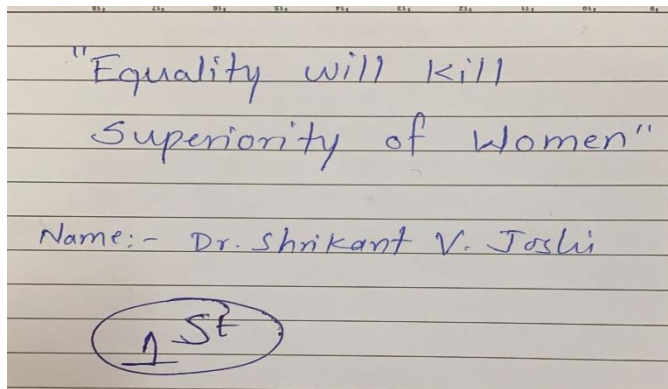




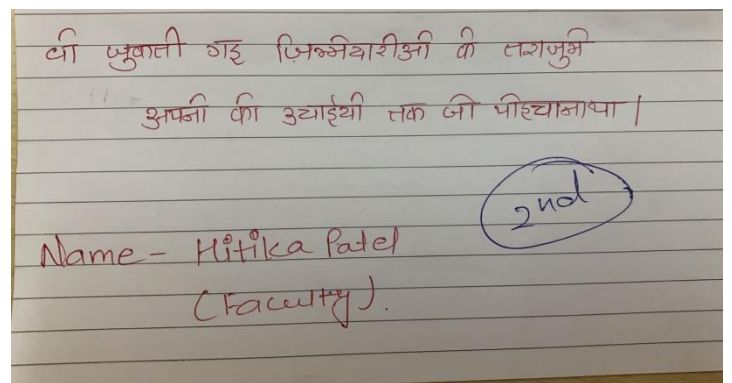
First Position, Mansi Mandot
