Under the celebration umbrella of 'Pharmacy Week' PharmD 4th year students visited Shrimad Rajchandra Hospital and Research Centre situated at Dharampur, Valsad on 26th November 2022.

The group of students and faculty member Dr Rutvi Vaidya were received by Ms. Prakshavi Naik – clinical research co-coordinator of hospital and alumnus of Maliba Pharmacy College. Her teammate Dr Gaurik gave verbal and pictorial information about Shrimad Rajchandra Hospital and their outreach activity to improve community health. Followed by formal gathering, the students were divided in two groups for visit of various departments at hospital.



The hospital has a 250 bed capacity spread across 2 lakh sq.ft. over 11 acres and many specialty units including;

Psychiatry

The main center of attraction of this hospital was disease early intervention center which mainly revolves around early assessment and detection of disease, syndromes or disabilities in neonates. During the visit some services and facilities were noticeable like special wing for maternity OT and wards, aquatic therapy, physiotherapy for neonates, auditory and visual exercise for disabled children, sensory garden, CT scan room with therapeutic view on top for relieving anxiety and provide relaxation, giraffe incubator for children etc.





Besides state-of-art facilities, cost efficient and unbiased treatments are provided to patients coming from any background. Hospital also endorses treatment through MAA card and Ayushman Bharat Yojna to non-affording patients.

During visit of all the wards students interacted with some patients and studied their cases through files. The record keeping department of hospital is well organized and with quick access by authorized person as and when needed. The head of record keeping department explained the system followed for various categories of patients like color code of files and various in the datasheets.

At the end of the visit, the hospital offered nutritious lunch at their hygienic canteen followed by closure meeting. On behalf of Maliba Pharmacy College, token of gratitude was presented to Dr Sunil Dubey – clinical administrator of hospital and Ms Prakshavi.
