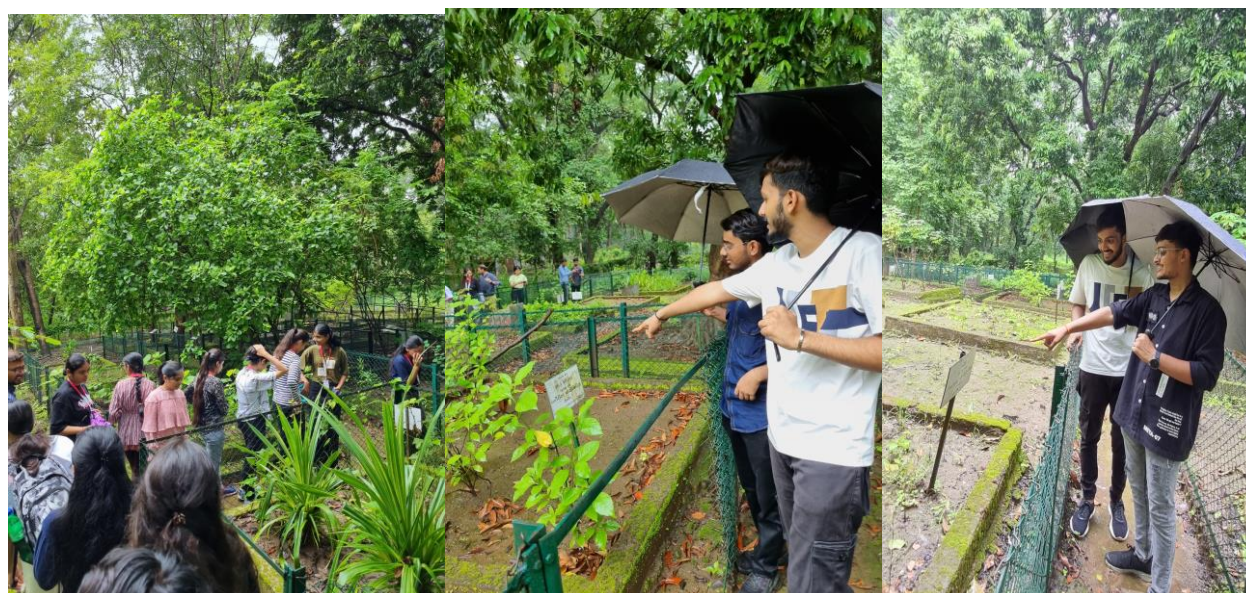
#### Highlights of Visit:
