The Industrial visit to RPGLS, Gujarat was organized by Maliba Pharmacy College on 24th April, 2026. The visit was coordinated by Dr. Pintu Prajapati, Faculty of MPC. 25 students of second sem. M. Pharm and one faculty members, Mr. Pratik Tailor visited the industry. The students were fortunate enough to get an opportunity to visit the plant approved by domestic and international regulatory authorities.

The students begun their journey at 8:45 am from Bardoli and reached the destination at 10:10 am. Mr. Parth Desai, the HR department of RPGLS, welcomed the group and provided a comprehensive overview of the industry. He discussed job prospects for pharmaceutical students and offered insights into the working culture. Two employees, engaged the students in a detailed discussion about the various unit operations involved in the manufacturing of Pharmaceutical products. This insight into the manufacturing processes was valuable for the students. RPGLS generously provided breakfast for all participants before the field visit, ensuring the students were well-prepared for the day.

For the field visit, the students were divided into two groups. The plant layout; material as well as men flow; the sensitization and gowning procedure were explained in the detail to the students of both the groups before entering into the premises. After wearing visitor's apron, shoe covers and caps, the students were allowed to enter the area. The raw material, warehouse area and production (formulation) and QA & QC areas were explained by RPGLS group.

The Following things were explained in detail in warehouse:

- a. Raw materials and packaging material flow
- b. Labelling to indicate status of material and label detail
- c. Storage
- d. Window to transfer the material from warehouse to production
- e. software for digital data maintenance.
- f. Men flow

The Following things were explained in detail in production area:

- a. MRO (material request order) and dispensing
- b. Change area
- c. Cleaning and validation
- d. Documents like BMR, SOPs, etc.
- e. Cleaning area.
- f. The sampling technique for IPQC test
- g. Manufacturing process and machine
- h. Special precautions for light sensitive materials,

The Following things were explained in detail in analysis department:

- a. Documentation
- b. Equipment for analysis.
- c. stability chamber.
- d. Case studies for need of data management and proper documentation

At the end all the students and faculties gathered again in the training hall. Mr. Parth Desai, the HR inspired the students by emphasizing the importance of adopting a multidisciplinary approach to become successful leaders in the pharmaceutical industry in the future.
