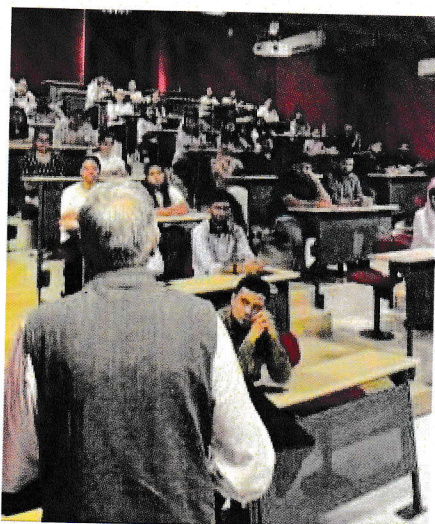
A yoga session was conducted by Dr. Bhavik Jhaveri, Assistant Professor, Shrimad Rajchandra College of Physiotherapy, focusing on relaxation, posture, and breathing exercises. Later, students visited the Matiya Patidar Ayurvedic Hospital for a health check-up under the supervision of Ms. Yashwini Kansara.



Dr. Bhavik Jhaveri delivered a lecture on “Role of Aerobic Exercise in Longevity.” This was followed by departmental overviews by Dr. Bhavin Vyas (Pharmacology and Pharmacy Practice) and Dr. Gajanan Kalyankar (Chemistry), who explained the significance of pre-clinical, pharmacological, and chemical sciences in pharmaceutical research.



The day concluded with an overview of the Training and Placement Cell by Dr. Pratik Tailor, highlighting internship and placement support for students.



The final day included a session on “Conduction of Examination and Evaluation System” by Dr. Hetal Patel, followed by a Keynote Address by Prof. P. R. Vavia, Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Technology, ICT Mumbai. His inspiring talk on “Innovation and
