About the Workshop

There are many Masters and PhD students doing research and submitting thesis to the various Universities of India but very few researchers apply for the patents. The purpose of patents is to encourage inventors to make an investment in time and money in research and development by providing exclusive rights for a limited time in exchange for an early public disclosure of the invention. India is a country that has understood the importance of strong patent systems for the growth of industry and commerce to bring it at par with the modern world. As per WIPO statistical database September 2018, 45,379 patent applications were filed in India. Out of which only 12,387 applications were granted and 29,789 applications were withdrawn or abandoned by the applicants. 3,203 patents were rejected on the ground of non-fulfilment of patentability criteria or non-patentability criteria mentioned under section 3 and 4 of Indian Patent Act. It is also an art to draft a patent text. This workshop is organized to guide the researchers about patent need, patentability criteria, patent drafting and patent filing procedure. Real case studies of pharmacy, engineering, chemistry, biotechnology, etc. will be discussed by the renowned experts. Hands on training for drafting a patent will also be given by registered patent attorney throughout a day.
